Mrs. Word Bird Suggestions

I bought a terrific colorful bird puppet at a shop on Pier 39 in San Francisco years ago. Its beak opened and when compressed it made a squawking sound that the kids loved. I used it with my Mrs. Word Bird songs with success and lots of eager enthusiasm from early learners. They loved feeding Mrs. Word Bird and hearing her chirp her approval. Option: Teachers may want to use a picture of a bird on a paper bag and the children can place the pictures into the bag through her tummy.

I put together a collection of picture cards to go with each song and I hid them throughout the classroom before school. After teaching the children the song, they looked for the pictures and came back to feed Mrs. Word Bird. ("This is ball and it begins with b.")

Copy the poem onto chart paper and after reading/singing through a couple of times with the children, ask them to highlight or frame the words that begin with the sound. It's important that you revisit the song to build confidence and familiarity with the text. You may also want to put them into student poetry notebooks for future independent reading.

The cards for two songs may also be used in an independent pocket chart sorting activity.

under every chair!


Look for bathtub and bacon and butterfly.


You'll find baby and books if you really try.


There are blocks, boat and bee,

Look for camera and coffee and chocolate cake.


You'll find candy and cow if you're wide awake.


There's a camel and coat,

'cause the c has got my vote!









Mrs. Word Bird (D)







Mrs. Word Bird (F)

under every chair!


Look for garbage and ghost and a bit of grass,

under every chair!


Look for honey and hotdog and a big hippo.


You'll find helmet and hockey and garden hoe.


There's a hose and a hook,

Look for mongoose and milk and an old mousetrap.


You'll find monkey and mop and a pirate map.
