Print on vellum, cut, and laminate for durability. Cut the top and bottom slits to the right of the blend for the slide. Model proper use for students: blending to form and say new words.

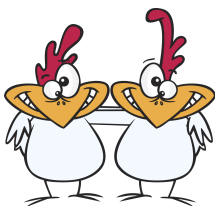
