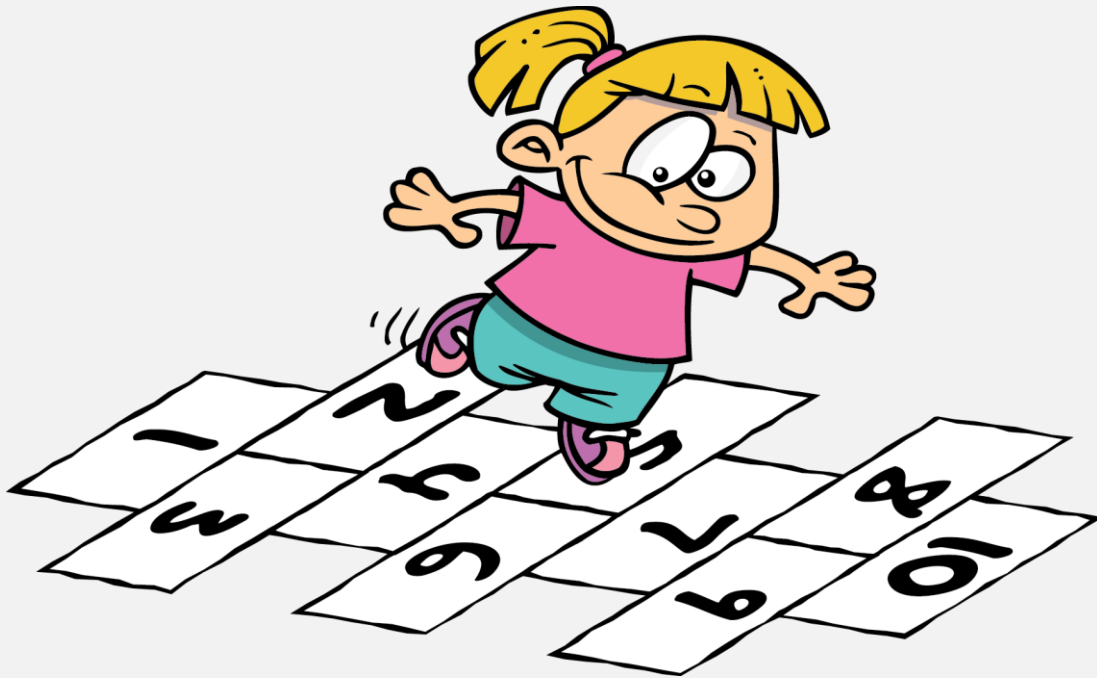

So they hopped and they clopped

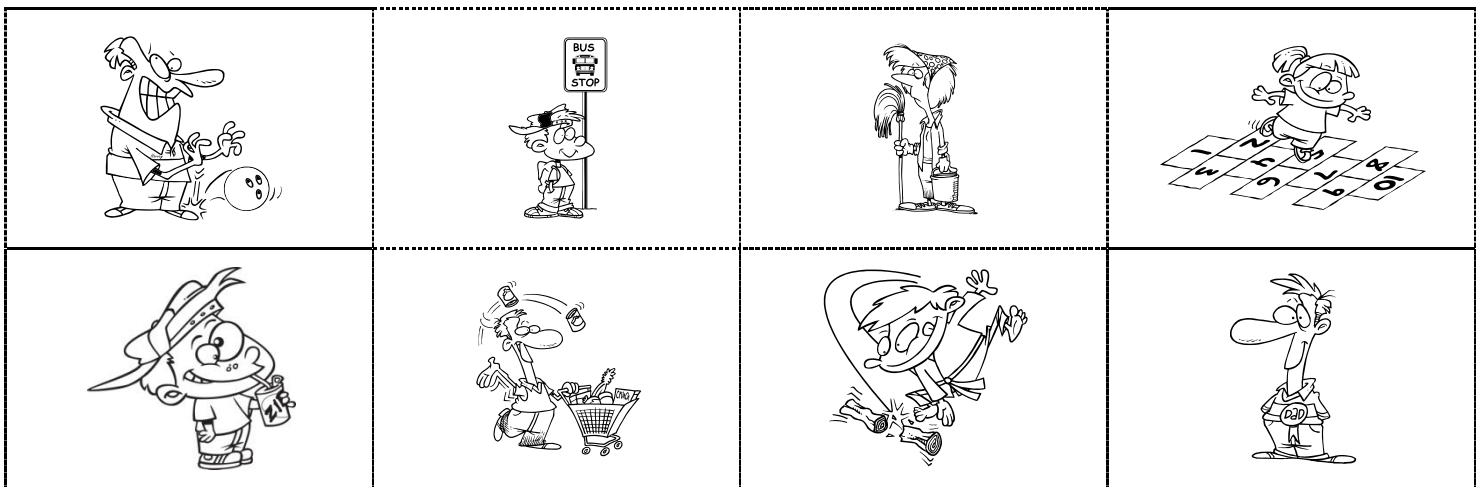
