spinning circles on the ground.

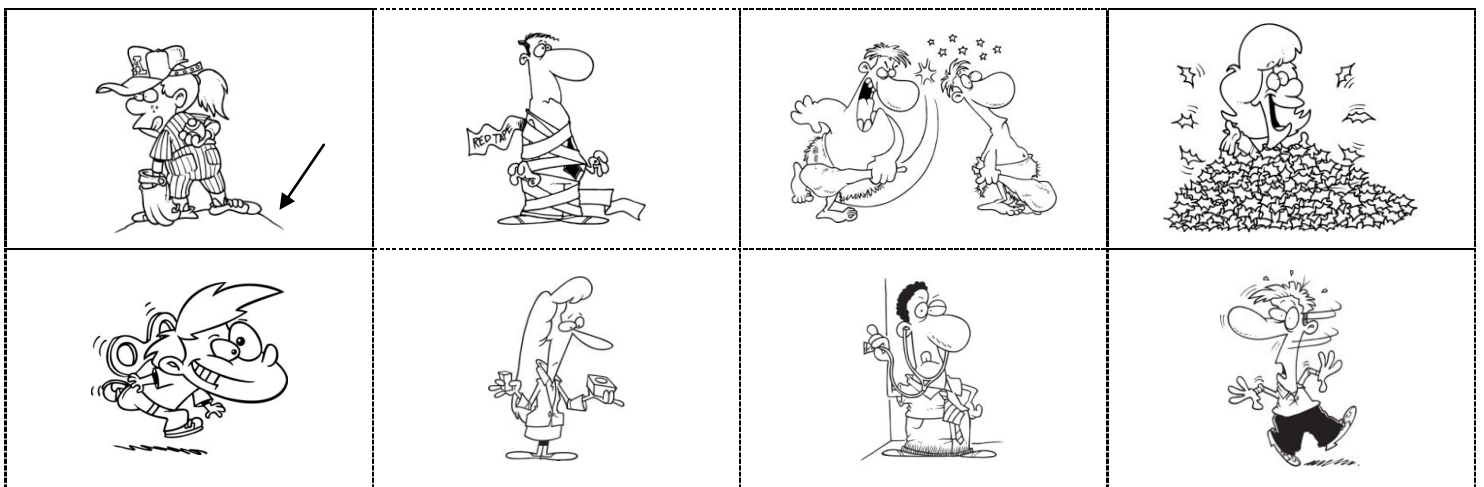
What to do with a dog that speeds?

I think I'll send him to his room!



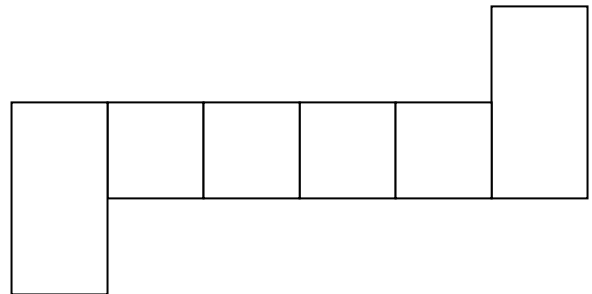
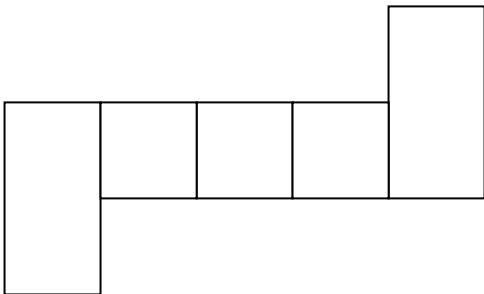
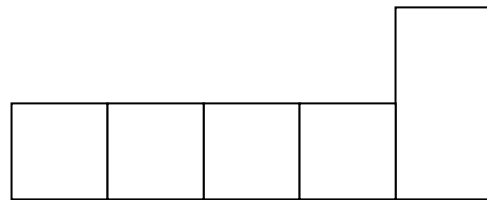
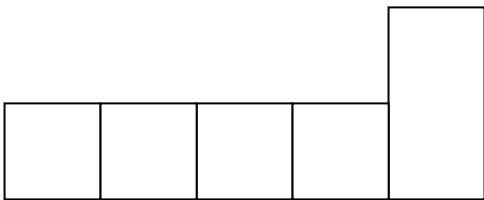
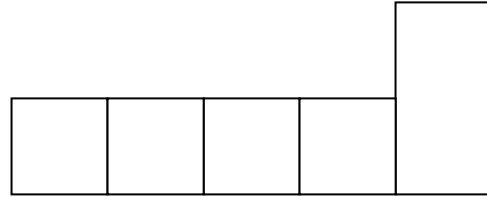
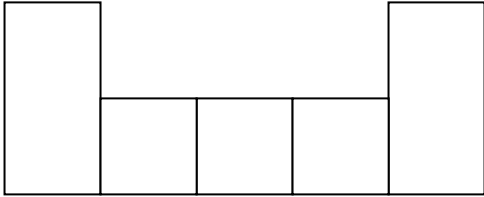
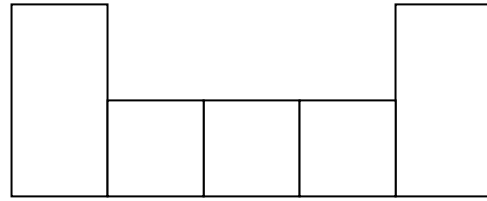
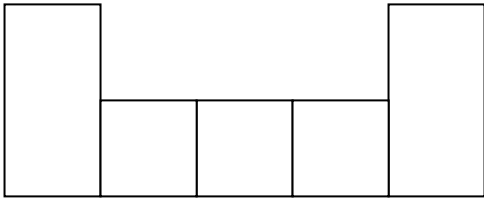

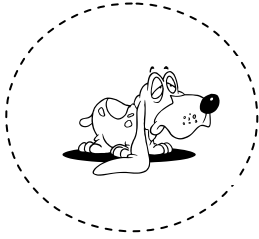

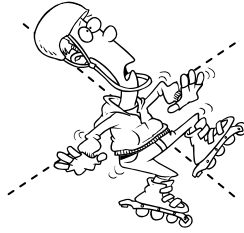
