Effective Teachers and Effective Schools



- * Communicate high expectations and clear goals
- * Establish a safe, orderly environment for students
- Create an atmosphere in which children view their school and classroom as a community of learners that can help one another learn and achieve
- * Maximize the time during which active instruction takes place
- * Interact with students regularly by asking questions, stimulating class discussion, and providing assistance during seatwork
- * Foster meaningful learning and higher-level thinking skills
- Teach knowledge and skills likely to be used both in and outside of school
- * Monitor students' progress toward instructional objectives
- * Consistently emphasize and acknowledge academic achievement
- Get parents actively involved in school life and in their children's learning
- * Make the improvement of instruction a high priority
