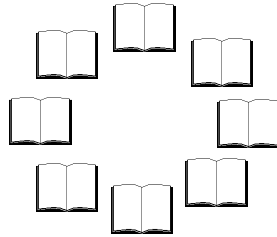


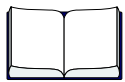
Readers' Circle



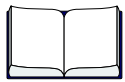
Why?

Reading is obtaining meaning from print. This meaning is fashioned by unique past experiences with the world and with language, leading to individual interpretation. In Readers' Circle, readers share this interpretation of text with one another. This process is more widely known as Literature Circles.

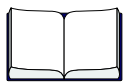
How?



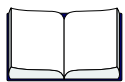
Readers' Circle could involve pairs or small groups.



Readers take turns talking about the material they have read.



Participants ask each other questions and read selected passages.



Research Circles may be organized when students have read reference material to find information for study.
