## Junior Jeopardy

### Assembly

#### Materials:

- ◆ Category cards (i-e, y, ight, i, short i)
- ◆ Point cards (100, 200, 300, 400, 500, Bonus)
- ◆ Answer cards (definitions only)
- ◆ Answer key for teacher (attached)
- ◆ Large pocket chart (available at teacher supply stores)
- ◆ Score sheet

### To play

- ◆ Player/team chooses category and point value.
- ◆ Teacher turns the answer card over and reads the definition
- ◆ Student/team then provides the answer in question format and spells the word.

Ex: Student: "I'll take short i for 100."

Teacher: "Opposite of lose."

Student: What is win? w-i-n.

- ◆ Bonus round: Each student/team chooses a bonus question and makes a wager from their points.
