

Working with Ordinal Numbers

While working with ordinal numbers, use this interactive bulletin board idea to practice skills.

Monday: Make five snowmen with hats (assorted colors) and smiles.

Tuesday: Change the mouths to show:

The first one is happy.

The second one is sad.

The third one is surprised.

The fourth one is mad.

The fifth one is crying.

Wednesday: Add different colored mittens.

Thursday: Add different colored bowties.

Friday: Add different sets of buttons.

Through questions and answers, discuss the colors of each snowman's hat, mittens and bowtie, as well as expressions and the number of buttons.

Example: Which snowman is surprised?

Which snowman has a blue bowtie?

What color hat is the third snowman wearing?

I'm a snowman with three buttons. Which one am I?
