# Plural Play Junior Jeopardy 

Assembly
Materials:

- Category cards (ies, s, es)
- Point cards (100, 200, 300, 400, 500, Bonus)
- Answer cards (definitions only)
- Answer key for teacher (attached)
- Large pocket chart
- Score sheet


## To play

- Player/team chooses category and point value.
- Teacher turns the answer card over and reads the definition
- Student/team then provides the answer in question format and spells the word.

Ex: Student: "I'll take -ies for 100."
Teacher: "another word for women"
Student: What are ladies? I-a-d-i-e-s.

- Bonus round: Each student/team chooses a bonus question and makes a wager from their points.
