Oh, I went to school, and I took my place, read some books about outer space. I wondered when we'd see the face of one or two guys from space!


Guys from space! Guys from space! Will they like the human race? I hope we'll never bring disgrace when we visit with the guys from space!













Directions for teacher/parent: Students circle each picture that ends with the *-ace* rime. They make an x on each picture that does not end with the *ace* rime.

Print the Partner Puzzle on vellum. Laminate for durability or print in gray scale for children to cut, color and glue.


