

(ose/oes) (Tune: Oh, Where, Oh, Where Has My Little Dog Gone?)









Directions for teacher/parent: Students circle each picture that ends with the -ose rime. They make an x on each picture that does not end with the ose rime.








ose Family Word Slide (Sound Blending)
