- Glue clues and answers on separate 3×5 cards.

To Play

Lay all cards face down on the floor or table in random order. First student turns over two cards. If the definition and the word match, they keep the pair. If they don't match, turn the cards back over and continue. Play until all cards are gone. Student with the most cards wins.
