- ◆ Category cards (ai, ei, -ay, a-e, short a)
- ◆ Point cards (100, 200, 300, 400, 500, Bonus)
- Answer cards (definitions only)
- Answer key for teacher (attached)
- ◆ Large pocket chart
- ♦ Score sheet

To play

- ◆ Player/team chooses category and point value.
- ◆ Teacher turns the answer card over and reads the definition
- ♦ Student/team then provides the answer in question format and spells the word.

Ex: Student: "I'll take ai for 100."

Teacher: "It falls from clouds."

Student: What is rain? r-a-i-n.

♦ Bonus round: Each student/team chooses a bonus question and makes a wager from their points.
