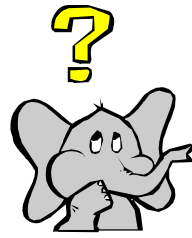


# Dolch Concentration



Print two copies of the Concentration card set on vellum or card stock and laminate for durability. Place a matching sticker on the back of each card to distinguish this set from others. The object of the game is to match two sight words. To play, the first player turns over two face-down cards. He reads the cards and if it's not a match, he/she turns the cards back over. The player with the most pairs wins.

Note: 40 cards may be too difficult for some children's visual memory. You may want to reduce the number of playing cards for some groups.
